#### PE ACTIVE WEAR UNIFORM

We are seeing a small number of children not wearing the correct PE day uniform. In assemblies over the next week, we will be reminding the children about the need to wear the correct PE uniform. Children will be told that after the Easter break, anyone wearing the incorrect PE uniform will be instructed to sit out of PE sessions. We trust that this will give parents time to obtain the correct PE uniform for their child if they do not already have it.



Our PE uniform must be **unbranded** unless you choose to purchase it from Whitakers where you can get it with the school logo on. It can be purchased from most supermarkets online.

- Plain white T-shirt or Hardy Mill logo sport shirt
- Plain black leggings or plain black track suit bottoms/joggers
- Plain black hoodie or zip up top
- Trainers
- Plain black shorts (in warm weather)

If there is a reason why your child is/ will be unable to wear the correct PE uniform after Easter break, please speak to Mrs Briggs as soon as possible.



#### **PTA UPDATE**

The Key Stage 2 Valentine's Disco was a huge success. Lots of happy children in their best party clothes showing us their best dance moves. The event raised another £184 which takes the total raised this year to £2829.50. £390 has been used to subsidise the cost of the children's pantomime before Christmas. £500 of this money has been used to support the Science Week 'Our World – Our Future' and £490 has been used to buy a shed for the Early Years as part of their plan to update the covered area.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

We know that sometimes our children cannot come to school because they are really unwell - and that's the right thing to do for them and other children. Medical advice is clear however that children with mild illness will often be well enough to attend - for example if they have a cough, or cold, without a temperature. The NHS guidance <u>Is my child too ill for school? - NHS (www.nhs.uk)</u> is designed to support parents in their decision making about mild illness.

We also know that children fall behind their friends and classmates when they miss school. At Hardy Mill school we want the amount of missed education to be reduced as much

as possible. We believe that our community is stronger together, with all of our children in school, on time, every day. We are building life skills, life-long friendships and preparing your child for future success.

To achieve the best attendance for our children, home and school need to work together.

#### Your role:

- Telephone the school or make an absence notification on ParentApp before 8.30am each day of your child's absence
- Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and provide appointment cards/letters.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, check the guidance <u>Is my child too ill for school? NHS (www.nhs.uk)</u>
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

### Our role:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Provide an update of your child's attendance as part of their termly report card.
- Advise you by letter if your child's attendance has fallen below 90% each half term and work with you to make improvements.
- Invite you to an attendance meeting where attendance is not improving over a half term to work together for improvement.

Any leave of absence (appointments etc.) during school time should be requested by email to <u>office@hardymill.bolton.sch.uk</u> or via Absence or Medical Notification tabs on ParentApp. Please refer to our school <u>Attendance Policy</u> for how these absences will be coded. Holidays will not be authorised except under exceptional circumstances and may result in a fine from the local authority.
